The ability to recognize these techniques will help you avoid impulse buying and help you take control of your money. When you know how a product is being sold to you, you have power over the purchase.

Here are some of the most common persuasive techniques:

- **Ethos:** uses credibility and authority
- **Logos:** uses logic or reason
- **Pathos (emotion):** uses words that evoke strong feelings, rather than facts and evidence
- **Ethical appeal:** taps into people's values or moral standards
- **Loaded language:** uses words with strong positive or negative connotations to stir people's emotions
- **Bandwagon:** persuades people to do something by telling them that others are doing it too
- **Plain folks:** implies that ordinary people are on "our side"
- **Snob appeal:** implies an ordinary person can be rich and sophisticated
- **Testimonial:** features famous people describing their personal experience with a product or explaining why you should use a product
- **Transfer:** uses the names or pictures of famous people to convince you that a product will help you imitate the famous person in the ad
