- Matter anything that takes up space
- An Element is one of the basic building blocks of matter and cannot be broken down by chemical means.
- It is even more surprising that that over 90% of the human body is composed of just four elements.
 - Carbon
 - Nitrogen
 - Oxygen
 - Hydrogen
- Atoms are the simplest unit of element that still retains the chemical and physical properties of an element.
 - There are the best-known subatomic particles are positively charged protons
 - Uncharged: Neutrons
 - Negatively charged: Electrons
 - Protons and Neutrons are located within the nucleus of an atom and electrons move about the nucleus
 - The circle around the nucleus of an atom represents an electron shell, which represents the average location of electrons
- The atomic number represents the number of protons in the nucleus of an element
- Mass number of an atom represents the sum of protons and neutrons in the nucleus
- The atomic mass (the number below the atomic symbol on the periodic table) is the average of the AMU for all the isotopes of that atom. To determine the number of neutrons, subtract the number of protons from the atomic mass and take the closest whole number.
- Isotopes of an atom have the same number of protons but different numbers
- Atom with more than one shell are most stable when the outer shell is also called shell contains 8 electrons.
- Ions are particles that either carry either positive or negative charge.
- The attraction between oppositely charged sodium ions and chloride ions form an ionic bond.
- Atoms share in covalent bonds
- A hydrogen bond is the attraction of a slightly positive covalently bonded hydrogen to a slightly negative atom in the vicinity
- Water has a high heat capacity
- Water has a high heat of evaporation
- Water molecules are cohesive and adhesive
- Cohesion refers to the ability of water molecules to cling to each other
- Adhesion refers to the ability of water molecule to cling to a surface
- Lemon juice, Vinegar, Tomatoes, and coffee are all acidic solutions
- Acids are substances that dissociates in water releasing hydrogen ions. The acidity of a substance depends on how fully it dissociates in water
