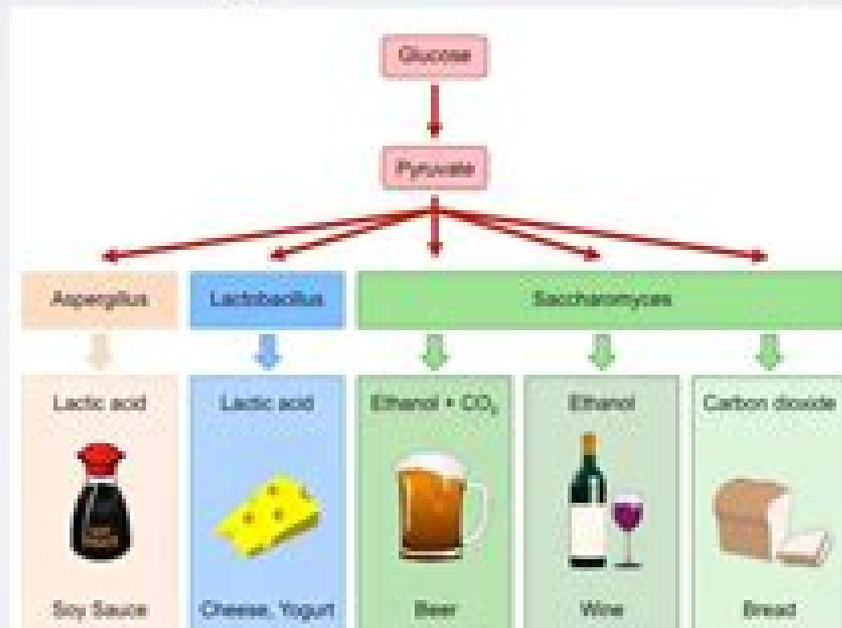


INTRODUCTION
