A New Planning Template for Transit-oriented Development Dick Nelson, 2001 The Mineta Transportation Institute MTI at San Jos State University assigned a project team to design a planning template for transit oriented development TOD that incorporates an understanding of nonwork travel that is trips for shopping eating out and engaging in recreational and cultural activities Nonwork trips are growing in significance and now account for four of every five trips At the same time TOD has become a popular planning response to the impacts of metropolitan growth Some planners believe that TOD will induce more pedestrian and transit trips and will reduce the average length and frequency of household auto travel This effect is assumed to result from improved accessibility to employment and nonwork venues located in compact mixed use centers Planning professionals in many MPOs also suggest that if multiple centers are linked by high quality transit such as light or heavy rail access is enabled to the broad range of nonwork activities
