

Key Points – Chapters 15, 16, & 17

- Three cranial nerves that stimulates the extra ocular muscles.
 - During ocular exam, movement of extraocular muscles: is stimulated by III, IV, VI
- Stimulation of the sympathetic branch of the autonomic nervous system dilates the pupil and elevates the eyelid. Parasympathetic nervous system stimulation causes the pupil to constrict.
 - When examining a pt eyes, sympathetic branch: elevates the eyelids and dilates the pupils
- Eye movements may be poorly coordinated at birth, but by 3 to 4 months of age, the infant should establish binocularity and should be able to fixate simultaneously on a single image with both eyes.
 - A mother asks when her newborn eyesight will be developed: approximately 3 months
- A normal response for the diagnostic positions test is parallel tracking of the object with both eyes. Eye movement that is not parallel indicates a weakness of an extraocular muscle or dysfunction of the CN that innervates it.
 - The nurse is performing the diagnostic positions test, normal findings: parallel movement of both eyes
- Pupils are small in the older adult, and the pupillary light reflex may be slowed, but pupillary constriction should be symmetric.
 - The nurse performing an eye assessment on an 80 y/o pt, which is abnormal: unequal pupillary constriction in response to light
- The muscle fibers of the iris contract the pupil in bright light and accommodate for near vision, which also results in pupil constriction.
 - The nurse testing a patient's visual accommodation: pupillary constriction when looking at a near object
- The palpebral fissure is the elliptical open space between the eyelids, and, when closed, the lid margins approximate completely. This does not result in problems with tearing nor indicate problems with increase intraocular pressure or extraocular muscles.
 - When examining the eye, the nurse notices that the pt eyelid margins approximate completely, this finding: is expected
- A simple increase in amplitude may not enable the person to understand spoken words. Sensorineural hearing loss may be caused by presbycusis, which is a gradual nerve degeneration that occurs with aging and by ototoxic drugs, which affect the hair cells in the cochlea.
 - A pt has been shown to have sensorineural hearing loss, during assessment: ask pt what medications he is currently taking
- Asians and American Indians are more likely to have dry cerumen, which appears white and flaky, whereas blacks and whites usually have wet cerumen that appears honey-brown. Dry, flaky cerumen in an Asian patient is not a result of poor hygiene, lesions from eczema, or change in cilia.
 - During assessment of 20 y/o Asian pt, dry flaky cerumen: is a normal finding, no further follow up necessary
