**Basic Ideas of Geography**


- Spatial approach – considers the arrangement of the phenomena being studied across the surface of the earth.
- Places may be large or small; the scale is important
- Places have both physical structure and cultural content
- The elements of places interact with other places.

### INTRODUCTION TO MAPS

**Map** a 2-dimensional representation of variables on the earth's surface

- **Reference Maps** – designed for people to refer to for general information about an area. (EX: political maps, physical maps, road maps, plat maps, locator maps)
- **Mental Map** an image in one's mind about an area, location, or environment
- **Thematic Map** represents a single variable over an area





**Map Projections:** process of showing a curved surface on a flat surface. Area, shape, distance, or direction may be **distorted**.

### GEOGRAPHIC DATA

- ❖ **Geospatial Technologies**
  - **GIS**- computer system that can store, analyze, & display information from multiple digital maps or geospatial data sets
  - **GPS** – receivers on the earth's surface uses the locations of multiple satellites to determine and record a receiver's exact location.
  - **Remote Sensing**- use of cameras or other sensors mounted on aircraft or satellites to collect digital images of the earth's surface.

### THE POWER OF GEOGRAPHIC DATA

Data may be gathered in the field by organizations or by individuals and data can come in a variety of forms.

**Fieldwork** – data that was observed and recorded on location

**Quantitative data** – information that can be measured and recorded using numbers (ex: distribution of people by income or age group)

**Qualitative data** – is not usually represented by numbers, harder to analyze, includes people's perceptions and feelings (interviews, document archives, descriptions, visual observations)

### SPATIAL CONCEPTS

- ❖ **Location:** Position on the Earth's surface.
  - **Absolute Location**
    - The exact position of a place
    - **Latitude and longitude** - used to describe a point on earth in reference to degrees
  - **Relative Location**
    - The position of a place in relation to the position of another place
    - Conveys interconnection and interdependence between different places
  - **Site** - Describes the physical and cultural characteristics of a location
  - **Situation** describes where a location is in reference to surrounding features in the larger region



- **Time-space compression** – the shrinking "time distance" between locations because of improved methods of transportation and communication.
- **Distance -decay** – the inverse relationship between distance and connection.
- **Density** – the number of something in a specifically defined area.

### HUMAN ENVIRONMENT INTERACTION

**Cultural Ecology** – the study of how humans adapt to the environment.

#### ❖ Cultural Change Theories

- **Environmental Determinism** belief that the physical environment is solely responsible for shaping human actions and behaviors.
- **Possibilism** belief that people, and not the environment, are the forces responsible for shaping culture.

### SCALES OF ANALYSIS

Analysis of relationships among and between places to reveal spatial patterns

- **Scale** - Relationship between the size of a feature as depicted on a map and the size of the feature in actuality

**Scales include:** global, regional, and local

### REGIONAL ANALYSIS

**Place** – refers to the specific human and physical characteristics of a location. A group of places in the same area that share a characteristics form a **region**.

- **Formal region**- an area that can be identified by its homogeneous cultural or physical characteristics
- **Functional region** - an area in which there is a center from which social or economic activities spread (aka nodal regions)
- **Vernacular (perceptual)** - an area not defined by any set of physical data, but by human conception of the area
