



Reader Response Criticism to Romeo and Juliet Essay Example

Romeo and Juliet is a play created by Shakespeare a very long time ago, but this play has been adopted into many other movies, plays, songs, and even phrases. In class we watched Romeo and Juliet, West side story, and Princess Bride. These are all renditions of the original and are unique in their own way, West Side Story is a musical, Princess Bride is a medieval story, and Romeo and Juliet is a tragedy. The groups are presented by red and blue. The red group is always more aggressive than the other and usually starts the fights. There are key people in each story that represent a certain person from the original. First are the leaders of the groups and their wife or girlfriend, then is the lovers, someone who hates the other group the most, the servant or best man of the lovers, someone else who wants the girl, and the middle man between the lovers who knows all the secrets. In all of these stories I preferred the Montagues side rather than the Capulets for many reasons.
