memories are transformed from a labile trace into a permanent store Scientists have shown that there are two distinct stages in memory consolidation one involving cellular mechanisms that underlie a fixation of changes in the neuronal connection strengths and the other involving a reorganization and reconstruction of the circuits that store and retrieve memories The book assumes little background knowledge from biology or psychology and is intended as a text for use in undergraduate courses on memory and cognitive science and for early graduate students in neuroscience cognitive science or biology It encapsulates the major concepts in the field and makes this area of research accessible to students who pursue a variety of related disciplines
