

Colour

Colour is often one of the most exciting components of a painting, but what exactly is it? Understanding the basic principles of colour theory helps you analyse how artists exploit and manipulate it to their work. They use colour together with composition, perspective, and light and shade to strengthen the impact of the artwork itself.

Mixing and comparing colours

The spectrum of light makes colours visible. Light travels in waves of different lengths, which give each wavelength a different strength or different colour. The range of wavelengths perceivable to the human visible spectrum – the visible light spectrum – spans an area, and the length of each colour can vary from four hundred nanometres (the shortest colour wavelength) and eight hundred (the longest wavelength) units. The colour in a painting can provide the viewer with information.


