The company was now in risk of losing this income at the hands of someone sabotaging their product line and the public was in danger if they consumed it. The company had to find out what the cause was and how to stop it. Had James Burke not acted swiftly, more people were at risk of being harmed and Johnson & Johnson could be looking at disastrous failure. By adhering to the Company Credo and pulling the product, he determined that the brand name could be saved if Johnson & Johnson restored public confidence by doing what was in the best interest for the public.
