BCE 200 CE outlined rigid caste based rules designating specific communities as outcastes and prescribing severe restrictions on social interactions occupations and religious participation Social ostracism was both a cultural and moral mechanism to enforce hierarchy legitimizing deprivation through religious sanction In rural economies Dalits were largely confined to occupations that sustained society yet were socially devalued ensuring their continued dependency and social marginalization Institutionalizing discrimination the caste system created enduring patterns of social exclusion that persisted through successive historical periods *Insight into Gandhi's Non-Violent Non-co-operation Movement* B.R.
