Given:

$$\begin{aligned} k &= 9.0 \text{ N/m} \\ x_0 &= 0.030 \text{ m} \\ x_1 &= 0.030 \text{ m} \\ m &= 0.200 \text{ kg} \end{aligned}$$

Solution:

$$\text{(a)} \quad v = x_0 \sqrt{\frac{k}{m}}$$

$$v = (0.030) \sqrt{\frac{9.0}{0.200}} = \boxed{0.50 \text{ m/s}}$$

$$\text{(b)} \quad v = \sqrt{\frac{9.0}{0.200} [(0.030)^2 - (0.030)^2]}$$

$$v = \boxed{0.24 \text{ m/s}}$$

$$\text{(c)} \quad x = 0$$

$$a = \frac{k}{m} x = (9.0 \text{ N/m}) (0)$$

$$= \boxed{0}$$

$$x = 0.030 \text{ m}$$

$$a = \frac{k}{m} x = (9.0 \text{ N/m}) (0.030)$$

$$a = \boxed{1.1 \text{ m/s}^2}$$

PROBLEM 10.

Given:

$$\begin{aligned} k &= 300 \text{ N/m} \\ m &= 2.0 \text{ kg} \\ g &= 9.8 \text{ m/s}^2 \end{aligned}$$



$$\text{(a)} \quad h = 2 \frac{mg}{k} = 2 \frac{2.0 (9.8)}{300} = \underline{0.13}$$

$$h = \frac{0.13}{2} = \boxed{0.065 \text{ m}}$$

(b) The mass's center point is a distance of 0.065 m below the point from which it was released.
