The failure to study this issue and others forces us to hold one position or another that is one's doctrines as a matter of tradition rather than the Inspired Doctrine of Scripture. While a lot of people go to church, very few actually know the Bible and take Jesus Christ our Lord seriously. Secular Christianity has been watered down, especially in the area of God's Word and its meaning, resulting in great division and confusion concerning many passages seen throughout scripture. The New Testament authors did write about prophecy, but a good percentage of their prophetic messages dealt with the immediate fate and future of national Israel. Thus, when they wrote prophetically, they wrote primarily about Israel's last days, i.e., the end of the Old Covenant age, while writing prophecy about the early Church's end of the age to come, as we read in Hebrews. So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many, and unto them that look for him, shall he appear a second time without sin unto salvation (Heb 9:28).
