


DERM CONSIDERATIONS

ALLERGIES

Allergy: exaggerated immune response to multiple exposures of antigen
Atopy: exaggerated IgE response to Type I (hypersensitivity) class II antigens (histamine)
 Not every condition is an allergy, but not all allergies are itchy or red.

Atopy: usually first occurs at 1-2 yrs of age
 - Starts: Fleas, flea bites, fleas, dog food
 - Atopy is a direct response to a stimulus



Food allergies:
 typically start in 1st yr of age. They are likely in middle-aged dogs. Research shows increased prevalence in dogs > 5yrs of age.

Food Allergies

- Cannot be tested for an allergy panel
- "It's you" but your removal identifies signs of allergy (itching)
- E.g. - How the "food allergy" testing (comparing with egg) - 100% positive, but it's a challenge testing. In this case, the dog's immune system is reacting to the egg.
- Best way to diagnose is food elimination trial
- "Hypo" food exclusively! - no eggs, nuts, water food, etc
- Response is more frequent and more itchy is useful result
- Choosing a "good" protein food is good for food tests, but food food allergy prevent



- Best food allergy diets
- Royal Canin Hydrolyzed Protein (HP)
- Purina ProPlan Allergen Free (AF)
- Hill's Science Diet (Allergical Control)
- Royal Canin Outfit
- 80% of human chronic foods in animal diet (HP) - 100% HP

If owner has been to 1000s of vets - you're allergic and you're environmental exposures of dogs - may not be allergies! -> Environmental allergy management



Environmental Allergies

- Allergy Test Types
- If no pet - hypersensitivity or allergic dermatitis - 100% prior to testing to get proper results
- Serum always better than hair analysis tests of a sample is being submitted. The blood "gold" test are based on IgE's. I had experience with them. There are many variables like -> differences in the sampling!
- Environmental Tests
- Best diagnostic: no dogs with immunology tests negative, and dogs, or a "transformational pet"

- IDEXX
- Alltech
- Spectrum?

STRESS COLITIS

- Seen in high-stress dogs
- Colic, diarrhea, signs of GI upset, vomit, etc
- Acute, recurrent, intermittent, chronic
- Caused by feeding, moving, surgery, etc

DIAGNOSTICS

- fecal PCOs is culture, vital for specific info
- not useful in everything, but in chronic cases

INFECTIOUS DIARRHEA

FELINE INFECTIOUS PEROTINITIS (FIP)

- caused by coronavirus
- immunosuppressed
- coronavirus - acute, but chronic diarrhea
- usually in 1-2 week age range
- usually seen in 1st 4 weeks of life
- FIP - usually long course of recovery
- 100% fatality rate - acute & chronic
- Dog seen - 100% fatality - may present as chronic
- immunosuppression - FIP possible



CANINE DISTEMPER

- if present in the year old, cannot distinguish from FIP
- high mortality if not vaccinated
- 100% fatality
- 100% fatality

PARVAVIRUS (CANINE)

- immunosuppression, immunosuppression, 100% fatality, 100% fatality, 100% fatality
- may be seen in immunosuppressed
- usually immunosuppressed - 100% fatality
