

Colour

Colour is often one of the most exciting components of a painting, but what exactly is it? Understanding the basic principles of colour theory helps you analyse how others might use colour in their work. They use colour together with composition, perspective, and light and shade to strengthen the impact of the artwork itself.


The colour wheel






