

# Stanislavsky's Legacy

The Stanislavsky System, a theory of the performing arts based on scientific research, is described in the book "An Actor's Work," published in 1938.



The basis for the Stanislavsky System lies in the breakdown of the actor's art into three components.



**Craftsmanship** - the use of prepared clichés, which allow the audience to immediately identify the emotion an actor is trying to portray.



**Experiencing** - in the process of performing, the actor undergoes genuine experience, and this injects new life into the role.



**Representation** - in the process of rehearsal, the actor undergoes genuine experience, which automatically forms the appearance of this experience, but during the performance itself the actor does not feel this and only reproduces the appearance.

## The basic concepts of the Stanislavsky System (selected highlights)

- Internal identification.** A method allowing an actor to completely experience the ideas and feelings of his character as if they were his own.
- Spiritual make-up.** The theoretical face paint needed for theatrical reincarnation.
- Effective analysis.** A rehearsal method in which dramatic structure is explored through the dynamics of interaction between characters in an imagined setting.
- Method of physical actions.** A rehearsal method in which actors develop a set sequence of actions for their characters.
- Theatrical partition.** The aggregate of the total actions of the actors.
- Supertask.** The unifying action that links together the various tasks taking place in the play.
- Through action.** The spine of the play that unifies all the moment actions in the play.
- Rhythmic tempo of the play.** The pace and rhythm of the play.
- Actor's ensemble.** The training system employed by Stanislavsky to perfect the actor's art.
