



## Summary: Amine Protecting Groups

Since amines are so nucleophilic, it's often desirable to mask their reactivity using a removable protecting group.


The most common situation is in **peptide synthesis**, where two amino acids are joined together. If the nitrogens of both amino acids are unprotected, then we can get undesired mixtures of products!



**Carbamates** are practical protecting groups for amines. They can be installed and removed under relatively mild conditions.



Two of the most common carbamate protecting groups are *t*-butyloxycarbonyl (Boc) and carboxybenzyl (Cbz).
