## Crabwalk:

**Memory and Complicity** Debarati Sanyal, 2015-03-02 Since World War II French and Francophone literature and film have repeatedly sought not to singularize the Holocaust as the paradigm of historical trauma but rather to connect its memory with other memories of violence namely that of colonialism These works produced what Debarati Sanyal calls a memory in complicity attuned to the gray zones that implicate different regimes of violence across history as well as those of different subject positions such as victim perpetrator witness and reader spectator Examining a range of works from Albert Camus Primo Levi Alain Resnais and Jean Paul Sartre to Jonathan Littell Assia Djebar Giorgio Agamben and Boualem Sansal *Memory and Complicity* develops an inquiry into the political force and ethical dangers of such implications contrasting them with contemporary models for thinking about trauma and violence and offering an extended meditation on the role of aesthetic form especially allegory within acts of transhistorical remembrance What are the political benefits and ethical risks of invoking the memory of one history in order to address another What is the role of complicity in making these connections How does complicity rather than affect based discourses of trauma shame and melancholy open a critical engagement with the violence of history What is it about literature and film that have made them such powerful vehicles for this kind of connective memory work As it offers new readings of some of the most celebrated and controversial novelists filmmakers and playwrights from the French speaking world *Memory and Complicity* addresses these questions in order to reframe the way we think about historical memory and its political uses today

*Futurity* Amir Eshel, 2013-01-14 When looking at how trauma is represented in literature and the arts we tend to focus on the weight of the past In this book Amir Eshel suggests that this retrospective gaze has trapped us in a search for reason in the madness of the twentieth century's catastrophes at the expense of literature's prospective vision Considering several key literary works Eshel argues in *Futurity* that by grappling with watershed events of modernity these works display a future centric engagement with the past that opens up the present to new political cultural and ethical possibilities what he calls futurity Bringing together postwar German Israeli and Anglo American literature Eshel traces a shared trajectory of futurity in world literature He begins by examining German works of fiction and the debates they spurred over the future character of Germany's public sphere Turning to literary works by Jewish Israeli writers as they revisit Israel's political birth he shows how these stories inspired a powerful reconsideration of Israel's identity Eshel then discusses post 1989 literature from Ian McEwan's *Black Dogs* to J M Coetzee's *Diary of a Bad Year* revealing how these books turn to events like World War II and the Iraq War not simply to make sense of the past but to contemplate the political and intellectual horizon that emerged after 1989 Bringing to light how reflections on the past create tools for the future *Futurity* reminds us of the numerous possibilities literature holds for grappling with the challenges of both today and tomorrow

Christopher Reichow, 2014-05-13 Essay from the year 2013 in the subject History of Germany National Socialism World War II grade 10 Diplomatic Academy of Vienna School of International Studies language English abstract The Second World War and its historical categorization remains a disputed topic within the German society Still the way of how Germans are rethinking their history is in a state of flux While the question of collective and individual German guilt has attracted increased scientific and popular attention since the late 1960s more precisely after the Eichmann and Auschwitz trials German intellectuals and the German media have in recent years turned their attention again towards German suffering during the war This can be seen as a recourse within a new framework Already in the immediate postwar period Germans depicted themselves as victims of the war and its settlement The preferred self image was that of being first a victim of Hitler's and then of enemies hands Once again though very late Germans today consider their own countrymen as victims In movies and books they depict themselves and their ancestors not only as villains but also as people who endured air bombing starvation and expulsion This revived way of storytelling began around the new millennium and focused especially on Germany's civilian population An important stimulus for Germany's coming to terms with its past or *Vergangenheitsbewältigung* was once again triggered by Günter Grass born in 1927 in Danzig one of the country's most popular and successful authors Already as a member of the famous Group 47 he had inter alia initiated a new concept to rejuvenate German literature particularly with his book *The Tin Drum* He also contested a denial of civic responsibility and guilt in past and present which he saw occurring in the consumerist driven Bonn Republic His first two books written in the new millennium the novel *Crab walk* published in 2002 and his autobiographic work *Peeling the Onion* released in 2006 were widely analyzed and sparked off a heated debate on both German guilt and German suffering By using both books as a case study this essay examines the main issues that were addressed by Grass and points out today's situation of German *Vergangenheitsbewältigung*
