Structuring Your Repository

For Python, in particular there are a few components that should exist within your repo and you must have all of these, at least in a basic skeletal form, before actual code begins.

License – [Root-Folder]: The representation of a set of **license** rights in a text or binary **file**, typically digitally signed and/or encrypted in order to prove authenticity.

README – [Root-Folder]: Getting a basic README file in place can help you describe your project, define its purpose, and outline the basic functionality.

Module Code – [Root-Folder] or [/module]: Be sure to place your actual code inside a properly-named sub-directory (e.g. /module), or for a single-file project, within root itself.
