1. Nature and Function of a State and its relationship with Law

Introduction

The word 'state' has been derived from the Latin word 'status', which means 'standing' i.e., position of a person or a body of person. The state is the highest form of human association. It is necessary because it comes in to existence out of the basic needs of life. The most important purpose of state is to make life possible and to protect the life.

It is difficult to give a precise definition of state because different political thinkers and jurists have defined it in different ways.

Salmond- "State as an association, of human beings established for the attainment of certain ends by certain means".

Goodhart- "The purpose of State is to maintain peace and order within a particular society. Therefore, the most essential purpose of state is to make life possible."

Aristotle - "State is a union of families and villages having for its end, a perfect and self-sufficing life, by which we mean happy and honourable life".

Woodrow Wilson- "State denotes a set of people organized for law within a definite territory".

Oppenheim- "a State comes into existence when people are settled in a country under its own sovereign government".

Dallas- "a State is a body of free persons, united together for the common benefit to enjoy peaceably what is their own, and to do justice to others".

Origin & Evolution of the State
