Entrance

The journalistic chronicle begins with an attractive hook to grab readers' attention without overwhelming them with too much information upfront.

Story chronological

The narration of the body of the note must contain the dramatization and climax of the chronicle, with increasing and decreasing actions to be able to handle the tension of the story.

Data

The text must offer basic information that completes the necessary points to understand and answer the traditional questions (what, who/is, where, when, why).

Final

The closing can include a serif that goes back to the hook that started the text.
