large The hidden layer use Receptive Field RF to process the input and thus it is frequency selective The output layer is only responsible for learning The learning is based on local learning The XOR classification problem is used to test the capabilities of the network There is a problem of continuous updating of weight arises This issue of weight is resolved by using STDP window and fuzzy reasoning The dissertation demonstrates how it is possible to obtain fuzzy reasoning capability from biological models of spiking neurons The fuzzy spiking neural network implements fuzzy rules by configuration of receptive fields antecedent conjunction with excitatory and inhibitory connections and inferencing via a biologically plausible supervised learning algorithm In this way the resulting system utilizes a higher level of knowledge representation
