European countries use trade to gain wealth

Kings and queens wanted to gain wealth - **to build larger armies and navies to dominate other countries.**

Europe wants to trade with Asia

A trader would want to buy items in Asia and sell them in Europe **to make a lot of money by selling luxuries (silks, carpets, & jewels) that were not available in Europe.**

Muslims controlled land routes to Asia

Land routes - the roads and trails people traveled to get from one place to another.

Muslims - people who controlled the land routes between Europe and Asia.

European traders had to solve their problem with Muslim-controlled land - **going by sea around Muslim-controlled land.**
