Thus Ariadne's voice frames and unframes the research context and plays alongside it. Ariadne's discourse attempts to seduce through a non-rational mytho-poetic love story which culminates in the wedding of Dionysus and Ariadne. Other non-rational discourses critically developed and based upon the work of Nietzsche: Jean Baudrillard and Gilles Deleuze are given voice and work together with Ariadne to counter the usual interpretations of Nietzsche's madness and of what mad discourse is. These discourses are given the names catastrophe, phantasm and seduction. The experiment of the book is not only to offer an entirely different perspective on Nietzsche's madness but to offer and perform new and challenging forms of affirmative discourse.
