underlying DOM structure It is able to propagate changes across its virtual tree as in the image above Virtual DOM Performance Handling the DOM manipulation this way can lead to increased performance Manipulating the DOM by hand tends to be inefficient and is hard to optimize By leaving the problem of DOM manipulation to a good implementation you can save a lot of time and effort React allows you to tune performance further by implementing hooks to adjust the way the virtual tree is updated Though this is often an optional step The biggest cost of Virtual DOM is that the implementation makes React quite big You can expect the bundle sizes of small applications to be around 150 200 kB minified React included gzipping will help but it s still big
