## The Fragmentation of Western Christendom

### 1) *Intro*

- ◆ In the third century ce, Christian missionaries began to spread their faith from the Med basin throughout the Europe
  - By 1000 ce, Christianity had established a foothold as far north as Scandinavia and Iceland
    - ◆ Although the peoples of Western Europe spoke different languages, ate different foods, and had different heritages
  - The western Europe
    - ◆ Followers of **Martin Luther** and other Protestant reformers established a series of churches independent of Rome
    - ◆ Roman Catholic leaders strengthened their own church against challengers
    - ◆ Throughout early modern times, religious controversies fueled social tensions

## The Protestant Reformation

### 2) *Roots of Reform*

- ◆ The **Protestant Reformation** dates from the early 16<sup>th</sup> century
  - Many of the underlying conditions that prompted reformers to challenge the authority of the RC church had existed for hundreds of years
    - ◆ Over the course of centuries, the church and its top officials had become deeply embroiled in the political affairs of western Europe
    - ◆ But political intrigues, combined with the church's growing wealth and power, also fostered greed and corruption
      - Undermined the church's spiritual authority and made it vulnerable to criticism
    - ◆ The hedonism and materialism of church officials only further emphasized the perceived betrayal of Christian ideals
  - Although the church continued to enjoy the loyalty of most Christians, it faced a disapproval of its abuses that became increasingly strident in the decades before 1517
    - ◆ Alongside such criticism came a growing demand for a more personal involvement with the divine
    - ◆ Efforts by church authorities to eliminate pre-Christian traditions and alternative kinds of spirituality only intensified the desire among laypeople for forms of devotion that would connect them more directly with God than the church allowed
  - Martin Luther coalesced these expressions of religious discontent into a powerful revolt against the church

### 3) *Martin Luther*

- ◆ **Martin Luther** (1483-1546) attacked the sale of indulgences as an individual
  - Soon attracted enthusiastic support from others who resented the policies of the Roman church
    - ◆ Luther published scores of works condemning the Roman church
  - His cause benefited enormously from the printing press
    - ◆ Had appeared in Europe in the mid-15<sup>th</sup> century
- ◆ It was **Johannes Gutenberg** (1395-1468) who introduced printing to Europe
  - His invention of mechanical movable type printing around 1439
    - ◆ Started a printing revolution
    - ◆ From his hometown in Mainz, Germany, printing soon spread to more than 200 European cities

**Elites and Classes in the Transformation of State Socialism** David Lane, 2017-09-08

The year 2011 marks the twentieth anniversary of the end of the Soviet Union. This may be an appropriate time to evaluate the adoption by previously state socialist societies of other economic and political models. The transition has sometimes been described in positive terms as a movement to free societies with open markets and democratic elections. Others have argued that the transition has created weak, poverty-stricken states with undeveloped civil societies ruled by unresponsive political elites. Which is the more accurate assessment? David Lane examines a few of the theoretical approaches that help explain the trajectory of change from socialism to capitalism. In contrast, he proposes a class approach in which two groups characterize state socialism: an administrative class and an acquisition class.
