correlations give reason to regard CSV a competitive tool rather than an alternative approach to CSR The concept is critically appraised from a societal perspective showing that CSV can be applied to benefit all but does not lead to shared value in itself In the second part of the dissertation an explorative study is conducted among energy suppliers and suppliers of outdoor equipment operating in the German market to find out whether Porter and Kramer's distinction between responsive and strategic CSR can be supported and whether CSV might deliver new options for the companies The study shows that companies are to a far degree concerned with responsive CSR and gives reason to embrace the idea that it depends on the corporation's product and business model whether the trend on CSR can be used strategically or has to be applied in a responsive manner The author introduces a management model putting into relation the concepts of CSR and CSV Plainly spoken CSR is considered the justification and underlying assumption while CSV is a management approach that can be applied to address corporate social responsibility
