- **All consumable activities are profitable due to the fact that they make contributions to consumption savings. However, society might not offer savings to individuals, activities which give demand as compensation to people who produce them are known as **Welfare activities**. Services may be undertaken the form of pay (either wages) or profit. Government services, production of goods for sale, and environmental therapy. These welfare activities do not provide the individual an income. They are done for self-consumption. The income, if given, resulting a lower output than the demand, a lower pricing range or both these factors.**
- **The non-market activities done by students are not paid, hence are included as national income. However, if this activity, like cooking, is performed for someone then it can be included.**
- **Education and skills of a person determines how he can work, as skilled people can perform better work than a person without any skills. However, generally there are skills and both education due to which we get our wages.**
