What is a database? - correct answer-a collection of related files containing records on people, places, or things

What is an entity? - correct answer-a generated category representing a person, place, or thing

What are attributes? - correct answer-specific characteristics of each entity

What is a primary key? - correct answer-A field (or group of fields) that uniquely identifies a given entity in a table

What is a foreign key? - correct answer-A field in one table that points to a primary key field in another table, creating a relationship between the two tables

What is normalization? - correct answer-Streamlining complex groups of data, minimizes redundant data elements, minimizes awkward many-to-many relationships, increases stability and flexibility

What is a data warehouse? - correct answer-A database that stores current and historical data that may be of interest

What is a data mart? - correct answer-Subset of data warehouses, highly focused and isolated

What is data mining? - correct answer-Finds hidden patterns and relationships in large databases and infers rules from them to predict future behavior

What is referential integrity? - correct answer-Ensure relationships between coupled tables remain consistent

What is a DBMS? - correct answer-Software for creating, storing, organizing, and accessing data from a warehouse
