<p><b>Headings and Subheadings</b> <b>Key Terms</b> Main Ideas, People, Themes</p> <p><b>Intro</b></p> <p>John Smith</p> <p><b>Charter of the Virginia Company</b></p> <p><b>England and the New World</b> Unifying the English Nation</p> <p>England and Ireland</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• April 26, 1607 three small ships carrying colonists sailed into Chesapeake Bay</li><li>• Choosing 60 miles inland on the James River to avoid Spanish pirates, they established Jamestown (named for the King of England) and colony of Virginia (for Elizabeth)</li><li>• Trip was sponsored by the Virginia Company not the crown in 1607 due to funding, when the ships returned 108 settlers remained</li><li>• Early leader of Jamestown, wrote "No man will go from England to have less freedom in America"</li><li>• Granted by James I in 1606 promised that colonists would enjoy all liberties of those residing in England, colonists wanted to enjoy greater rights including elected assemblies, protection of common law, access to land, economic independence</li><li>• English exploration and colonization commenced far after John Cabot's encounter of North America in 1497</li><li>• The Crown had internal struggle, period of civil war, Reformation, Establishment of the Church of England, Religious persecution until Elizabeth I (1558-1603) restored Anglican ascendancy</li><li>• Long struggle of the English to conquer Ireland lasted well into the 17<sup>th</sup> century, absorbing money and energy that might have been devoted to the New World</li></ul>
