


Chapter 6: Integumentary System

- Integumentary system consists of skin & accessory organs (hair, nails, & cutaneous glands)
 - Inspection of skin, hair, & nails is significant part of a physical exam
 - Skin is most vulnerable organ b/c it is exposed to radiation, trauma, infection, & injurious chemicals
 - Skin receives more medical treatment than any other organ system

Dermatology – scientific study & medical treatment of integumentary system



- Skin
 - is body's largest & heaviest organ
 - Covers 1.5-2.0 m²
 - Composes 15% of body weight
 - Layers of skin include epidermis, dermis, & hypodermis
 - Skin thickness ranges from 0.5-6 mm
 - Thick skin covers front of hands & bottoms of feet
 - Has sweat glands, but no hair follicles or sebaceous (oil) glands
 - Epidermis is ~ 0.5 mm thick
 - Thin skin covers rest of body
 - Possesses hair follicles, sebaceous glands, & sweat glands
 - Epidermis about 0.1 mm thick
